Annual examinations were held. Out of the 150 children enrolled, 141 children passed, with 101 obtaining results that placed them in the first division.

Parent/Teacher meetings were held when parents were briefed on their child's progress.

A new computer was installed in the office, and accounting software was installed. This vital investment was generously donated by Prem, in whose honour the school is named.

The Chief Child Officer from the Department of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of Rajasthan visited Prem Pathshala and the shelter home.

A paved area was constructed in front of the shelter home and a pathway now links the shelter home and the school which will help to keep the buildings cleaner.
